

We are open from 5:00 to 10:00 or as late as people want to stay.



From the Desk of the Secretary – Bill Chelonis

A few items of interest while a member is filling out an application for a new prospective member:

Proposers should put their NAME; ADDRESS, and PHONE Number and SIGN the "front side" of the application. They should also, on the "Backside," fill in the section that says "PROPOSER" and sign that as well. Many Proposers are NOT doing this.

Prospective Member: The proposer should make sure the prospective candidate fills out the application COMPLETELY and signs and dates it. I am finding many applications that are not properly completed, and I have to return them to the proposer and/or prospective candidate to complete. This delays the process for the new prospective member.

The candidate also needs to pay \$75 for the application fee. We find that many need to do this, which delays bringing in new members.

### LODGE CLEAN-UP REMINDER


Please remember Lodge Cleanup on the 1st Wednesday of each month at 9:00 am. The next one is on July 3rd.


