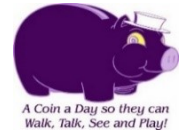

Hello Fellow Elks,

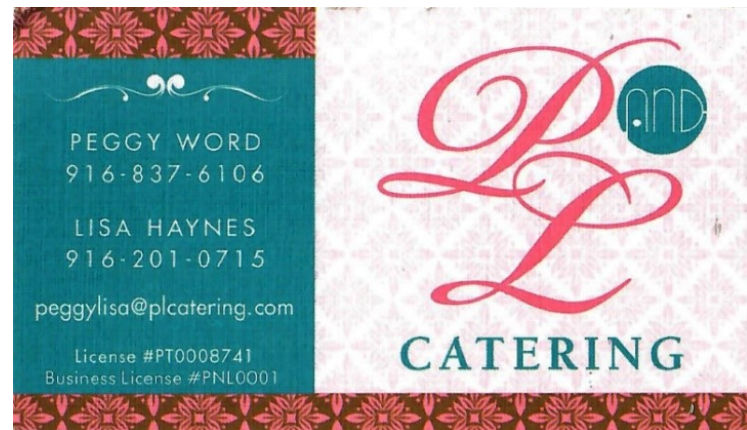
I have taken a brief vacation that was scheduled for more than a year, or what should have been a vacation. I will share my adventures with you when I get back.

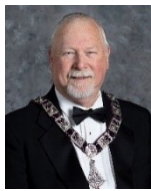

VETERANS CORNER

August is here, and it is the middle of our summer season. Vacations are coming or now gone by. Enter now our plans for the fall and our kids returning to school, reuniting with school friends, making new friendships, and setting new goals. This is what life is all about. It is also the time of year when our Veterans Committee enjoys some downtime and prepares for the upcoming annual activities we are involved in.

I trust your 4th of July celebration was safe and sane. Fireworks are a big part of that celebration. We watched a big fireworks display from the beach at Camp Richardson in South Lake Tahoe. I have enjoyed this Lake Tahoe event for most of the last fifty years.

As the Northeast District's chairman for the National Veterans Service, I will head up a group of Elks throughout our District who will put on a BBQ at the Reno VA hospital. This event is identical to the event we participated in with our Lodge at the Reno VA hospital. This BBQ will take place on Saturday, August 3, 2024. We are still in the process of determining who we will be able to feed. Our goal is to feed everyone in the hospital on that day, which will be about 175 people, including patients. Working out the logistics has become a bigger task over the last five years. Our reward increases as we go forward and solve each of these hurdles. That is the satisfaction that all our Veterans in the hospital receive a wonderful meal that is never included in the hospital menu plans, along with live entertainment. The smiles on the patients' faces are reward enough for me. The Elks and your generous donations pay for this event and our lodge event. I will report back to you in the September issue of our Bulletin.

We have many dates to remember that took place in August and affected our Veterans. August 2, 1990, the Gulf War Operation Desert Shield began; August 4, 1790, the U.S. Coast Guard was established; August 6, 1945 the Atomic bomb was dropped on Hiroshima; August 7, 1782, the Badge of Military Merit (Purple Heart) was established; August 9, 1945, the Atomic bomb was dropped on Nagasaki; August 15, 1945, Japan accepted unconditional surrender terms; August 21, 1965, the Civil War was officially declared over; August 26, 1972, the last Army combat ground forces departed Vietnam. These are but a few of the many dates in American history that took place in August. For those interested in knowing more about these important dates, one such resource is a calendar available through the National Museum of the United States Army. Unless you fly your American flag daily, remember to fly it on those dates you consider significant as a tribute to our American fighting men and women.

As I conclude this article, please take some time to ruminate on our present and past veterans and what they mean to you. Remember our military on duty serving around this glorious world of ours. Pray for your family and friends. I wish everyone good health, a speedy recovery from any illness, and much happiness. No matter what your religious beliefs are, your prayers are always welcome. 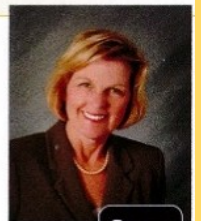
