It has been great assistance to me in getting reports out, dues statements, delinquent notices, bulletin address lists, monthly birthday lists and mailing labels, membership roster, and many other things. This CLMS also requires the lodges to have internet access to upload copies of our database to Grand Lodge so they can keep current records of membership to compare addresses on file for the Elks Magazine, published every other month, and the two annual reports.


