

VETERANS CORNER

April is charging in with some beautiful spring weather and flowers. Get ready for some summertime activities. This is also when we begin our new Elk year with new leadership in our Lodge. Welcome them with your attendance at a Lodge event. At this time, I would like to thank everyone who donated to our Lodge Veterans fund along with your dues renewal. That money supports all our Veterans events in our Lodge. Thank you again.

The Placer Veterans Stand Down is scheduled for May 5th - 8th, 2025. The 5th and 8th are the setup and takedown days, respectively. All services will be available to the Veterans on May 6th & 7th. Plan on attending if you need any of their free services (all services are FREE to the Veterans) on either day. Parking is also free. There is nothing to pay for. All the meals served on both days are free as well. Services for your dog are also free. There will be clothing there as well (all free). The following services will be available. Meals and optional overnight accommodations, haircuts, and showers; pet services: veterinarian staff, vaccinations, and supplies; clothing and personal care supplies; Health & Human Services Assistance as well as Integrative Health Services; Dental, medical, and Vision services; Employment counseling and housing referral; VA benefits assistance, and PTSD counseling and assistance.

Next month, we are planning our annual May trip to the VA hospital in Reno, NV, on May 17th. If you are going to participate in this wonderful event, please be at our Elks Lodge by 9 a.m., as it takes two hours to get to the hospital. We try to carpool whenever possible and plan to return to Auburn by 4 p.m.




