From the Desk of the Secretary - Bill Chelonis

An interesting Section of the GL statutes is 14.050, indicating that an application for membership may be withdrawn by the proposer in open lodge, at any time prior to balloting on the applicant, unless three members of the lodge object to the withdrawal. Also, the Lodge Secretary is under no duty to notify the applicant of such withdrawal, as this rests upon the proposer who withdrew it. All fees paid will be refunded to the applicant. In Section 14.030, in balloting on an applicant, there must be two-thirds of the votes cast; otherwise, the application is declared rejected. For the purposes of voting upon an applicant, a white ball shall be considered an affirmative vote; a black cube shall be considered a negative vote.






